

Jai Ho Again! Slumdogs Recover Stolen Bowling Trophy

Trailer 34 news agency reported today that the 2009 Bowling Champions Omega Slumdogs successfully recovered the Omega championship bowling trophy at 11:13am Sunday morning. The Slumdogs have been planning the secret mission for weeks, and struck swiftly in a morning reconnaissance mission to recover the stolen cherished trophy after the order was given by Mayor Andrew Milford.

"We used a combination of remote viewing, a tip from an anonymous spirit guide, plus some special forces training with former Sheriff Omega Chervl Champagne," said Brett Bevell, the one who organized the trophy rescue mission on Mayor Milford's behalf. "Once the location was fully known, it was only a matter of waiting for the right time to strike."

The ground assault began shortly after 10:59am when Mayor Milford received information from Staff Programs confirming that trophy location was indeed the office of Operations Agent Chuck MacCabe. Upon knowing the

Mayor Milford location, then issued an executive order for the reconnaissance mission to begin. Both Mayor Milford and Staff Programs Coordinator Brett Bevell lead the special forces team, riding in to the Maintenance shed on a camouflaged cart where they quickly and safely recovered the trophy with no casualties reported. By 11:13am, the trophy was in safe hands and relocated to the Dining Hall, where it had been displayed at the time of the original theft over one month ago.

"I credit former Sheriff Cheryl Champagne for teaching me Bulldog pose over the past few days, which really keeps up your sense of persistence," Brett Bevell said to an enthusiastic group of reporters. "Once she gave me that last lesson, there was no turning back."

A brief ceremony took place in the dining hall to honor the return of the trophy. And Peggy Fitzsimmons of Omega Quality Control reported an immediate drop in complaints from guests once the trophy



was returned. "Justice has prevailed," said Mayor Milford, who will be hosting the trophy in the Mayor's Mansion for the next week. Slumdog team members agreed back in March that the trophy would be shared among their teammates. And in honor of the

democratic nature of their team, the tradition will go on despite the temporary failed theft attempt by Agent MacCabe.
