September 5th, 2009 at 8pm,” proclaimed the Mayor.

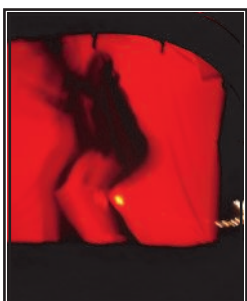
