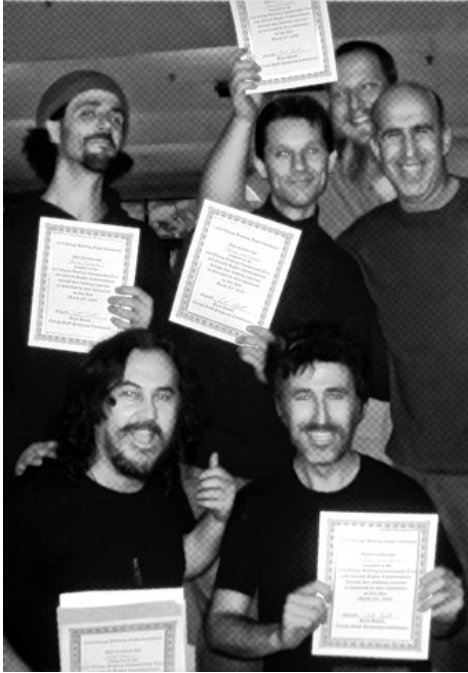


Mayor Ushered Away in Bowling Attempted Coup: Championship Game Awaits
